This was certainly an important project to be a part of; a successful installation that we were privileged to be chosen for.

In 2021 a fire at Christchurch City Council's wastewater treatment station sustained serious damage to the infrastructure, causing locals to complain about the resulting odour. Significant efforts were deployed to rectify the issues and replace sections of the plant, allowing it to return to normal operations. These impressive new bypass lines form a crucial part of



that process, carrying 1500 – 1900 litres per second through the treatment plant. Of course, throughput of this magnitude means even a small bump from a passing vehicle could create disaster. Super-strength barrier protection was called for, so Tru-Gard™ Certified Safety Barrier was used to encircle the valuable infrastructure, keeping it safe from inadvertent impact. As they say, prevention is better than cure, and in this case the safety yellow colour is a visual stand-out that gives clear warning well ahead of accidental collision. Good job Seipp Construction Ltd, this installation looks absolutely watertight!

The 11,000 sqm development will change the way produce is moved from local growers to Countdown's South Island customers, optimising the supply chain, ensuring product quality and reducing the spoilage of fresh fruit and vegetables.
