NEW BARRIER OPTION: Why get super heavy-duty barrier when your impact risk is lighter?

Sometimes you just don't need to invest in the superlative option when a simpler version will do the job.

While we're proud that we can supply heavy barrier that will stop a 23 tonne truck, you don't actually need this when all you have to stop is a pallet trolley or similar light-weight conveyance device. So let's cut out the overkill!

We've come up with a solution that still provides certified protection for pedestrians yet it's far more suited to light traffic areas than a heavy barrier system. By matching risk mitigation to the level of environmental hazard, you can achieve both value for money and peace of mind.

While providing a desirably smaller footprint, the medium barrier's strength and impact resistance has been fully tested and certified, and its high visibility is an invaluable feature. As a pedestrian separation device, this barrier will provide more impact protection and greater yellow mass than its lighter handrail alternative.

Check out these highlights from our project at Winstone Wallboards, Tauranga.

Our R&D team took safety design to the next level by custom-building these tunnel walkways to secure and streamline pedestrian traffic in risky environments. The project was completed with our New Zealand sales partner Vanguard Group Ltd. Together we collaborated with Winstone Wallboards to design a unique tunnel barrier system to protect staff from traffic impact and the risk of falling objects. These tunnels are not only long, spanning an impressive 130 meters through their distribution centre, but also strong enough to withstand weights up to 400kg falling from as high as 800mm.
